To observe Divine Mercy Sunday fittingly, we should precede the feast by a nine-day novena of reciting the Divine Mercy Chaplet, beginning on Good Friday (privately said).

Jesus asked Saint Faustina: *“Gather all sinners from the entire world and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy . . . On the day of my feast, the Feast of Mercy, you will go through the whole world and bring fainting souls to the spring of My mercy. I shall heal and strengthen them.”* (Diary 206)

“The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.” (Diary 699)

“When you approach the confessional, know this, that I Myself am waiting there for you. I am only hidden by the priest, but I Myself act in your soul.” (Diary 1602)



Jesus said to Saint Faustina:

“I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My mercy are open.

The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.” (Diary 699)

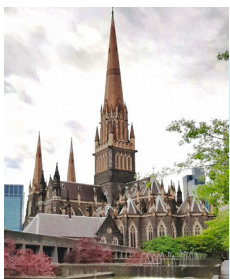

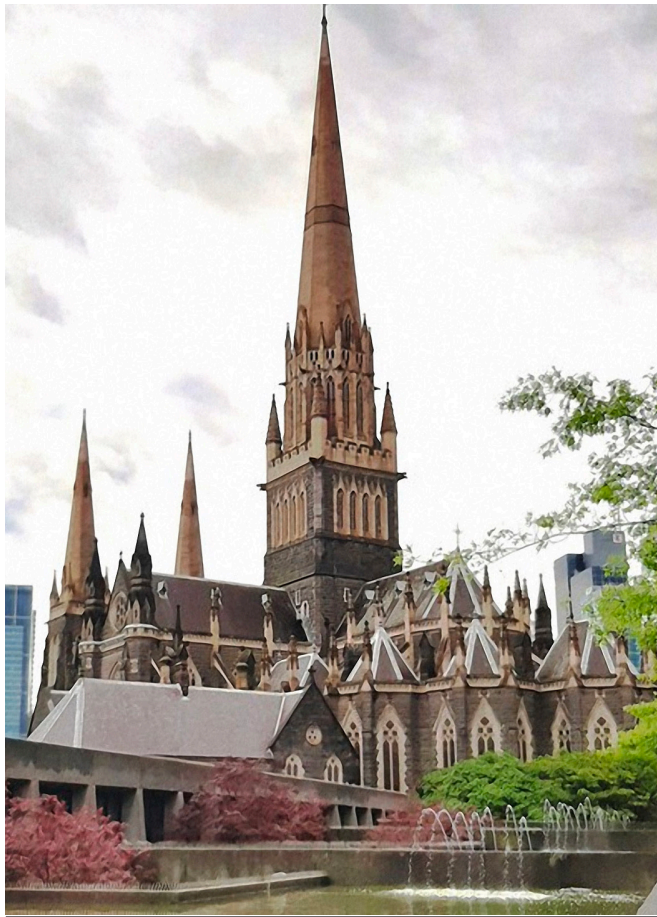

How to Prepare for the Feast of Mercy

To observe Divine Mercy Sunday fittingly, we should precede the feast by a nine-day novena of chaplets to the Divine Mercy, beginning on Good Friday (privately said) and:

1. **Celebrate** the Feast on the first Sunday after Easter;
2. Sincerely **repent** of all our sins;
3. Place our **complete trust** in Jesus;
4. Go to **Confession** on that Sunday or within seven days before or after the Feast;
5. Receive **Holy Communion** on the day of the Feast;
6. **Venerate* the Image** of The Divine Mercy;
7. **Be merciful** to others, through our actions, words and prayers on their behalf.

* To venerate a sacred image or statue simply means to perform some act or make some gesture of deep religious respect toward it because of the person whom it represents - in this case, our most Merciful Saviour.

Solemn Act of Entrustment of the World to Divine Mercy

Except from homily by Pope John Paul II

at the Dedication of the Divine Mercy Shrine in Łagiewniki, Poland, 17 August, 2002

“Today ... in this Shrine, I wish solemnly to entrust the world to Divine Mercy. I do so with the burning desire that the message of God’s merciful love, proclaimed here through Saint Faustina, may be made known to all the peoples of the earth and fill their hearts with hope. May this message radiate from this place to our beloved homeland and throughout the world. May the binding promise of the Lord Jesus be fulfilled: From here there must go forth *‘the spark which will prepare the world for His final coming.’* (Diary 1732)”

God, merciful Father, in your Son, Jesus Christ, you have revealed your love and poured it out upon us in the Holy Spirit, the Comforter. We entrust to you today the destiny of the world and of every man and woman. Bend down to us sinners, heal our weakness, conquer all evil, and grant that all the peoples of the earth may experience your mercy. In You, the Triune God, may they ever find the source of hope.

Eternal Father, by the Passion and Resurrection of your Son, have mercy on us and upon the whole world! Amen.
