#### Saturday, 3 May - Anne Slingo - Journey of Hope

#### Share the graces of the Camino - the pilgrimage of hope.

With over forty years of teaching experience in Catholic education and a background in Ignatian spirituality, Anne has dedicated her recent years to formation work and spiritual guidance, including a transformative Ignatian Camino pilgrimage in 2023.

#### Saturday, 7 June - Very Rev Dr Brian Boyle EV - Jubilee

*Explore in depth the concept of Jubilee and its implication for the current context of the world.* 

Fr Brian, an adjunct lecturer in Biblical Studies and Episcopal Vicar for Education, holds a Doctorate in Sacred Theology and has published works on the Old Testament, including a focus on the Book of Jeremiah.

#### Saturday, 5 July - Fr Frank O'Loughlin - Eucharist: Until He comes again

The Eucharist looks not only to the past but also to the future - the feast in the Father's Kingdom. Fr Frank, a renowned theologian and adult educator with a doctorate from Urban University, has served as a priest in the Archdiocese of Melbourne, lectured in theology, directed the Liturgical Centre, and authored several books.

#### Saturday, 2 August - Mark Cooper - Reconciliation: We are One

#### It's all about connection with God's incredible presence in All.

Mark, who grew up in Djilang/Geelong, worked in West Papuan refugee camps at 19, was ordained a Passionist priest in 1992, and has deepened his faith through friendships with Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander, and diverse cultural communities.

#### Saturday, 6 September - Fr Michael McEntee - Prayer for the Journey

Ever grateful to his Father, Jesus prayed for discernment, for succour and strength, for his enemies.

Fr Michael, a former lecturer at CTC, has significantly contributed to theological education and pastoral formation across Australia and internationally, and now enjoys supply ministry in retirement.

#### Saturday, 4 October - Fr Frank O'Loughlin - Viaticum: Food and Strength for the Journey

As death approaches for a Christian, we celebrate Viaticum, a word meaning 'what you need for the journey' and pray the Commendation of the Dying, entrusting the person into God's hands. In that moment of approaching death, these rites reflect what we celebrate in every Eucharist.

#### Saturday, 1 November - Professor Margaret O'Connor AM - Works of Mercy

Care at the end of life

Margaret, an Emeritus Professor at Monash University and recipient of the Order of Australia, has had a distinguished career in palliative care, including roles in education, advocacy, and leadership, and continues to serve as a Board Director and Chair in aged care.
