Position: Musician for Sunday Mass (organist OR a keyboard player OR a guitarist)

Reports to: Parish Priest

Conditions: Part-time employment, 2hrs per week

Duties:

- To prepare the liturgical music program for the parishes Sunday Masses.
- Lead the congregation in singing
- Work with the choir volunteers, including parents and children
- To be available to play or support musicians each Sunday
- Other duties as directed by the Parish Priest.

- A competent keyboard musician and singer
- Ability to plan music programs
- Able to work with parish volunteers
- Knowledge of Catholic liturgical music.
- Experience in leading a congregation in singing
- A thorough understanding of the celebration of the Eucharist
- An energy, passion and vision that has the capacity to ensure that the music/musicians/singers enrich the prayer life of the worshipping community
- Proven ability to promote, train and coordinate liturgical musicians from within a broad cross section of liturgical music.
- Proven ability to work as part of a team.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Commitment to the Child Safety Standards of the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne.
