## In this role, you will be responsible for key areas such as (but not limited to):

- Coordinate and/or conduct visitation to hospitals and Nursing Homes within the Parish;
- Coordinate and/or conduct pastoral visitation to homes within the Parish;
- Liturgical Support at weekend Masses;
- Coordinate and/or conduct the ongoing visitation of the bereaved;
- Coordinate a Bereavement Support Group;
- Assist when required in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults;
- Assist when required to coordinate and implement catechesis for the sacraments of Baptism and Baptism preparation team.
- Assist when required to Work with Parish Liturgical Teams in planning for Sunday Eucharist's and for the liturgical seasons of the year;
- Assist when required with liturgical functions, to lead prayer services and provide other devotional opportunities;
- Assist when required to coordinate and lead marriage preparation programs for engaged couples. To assist engaged couples in the preparation of their marriage liturgy;

- The ability to work cooperatively with the group;
- A capacity to facilitate ministry initiatives using the skills of Parishioners;
- A capacity to work effectively with volunteers across various Parish ministries;
